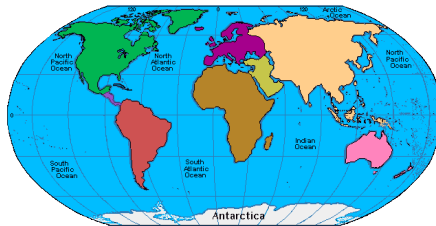

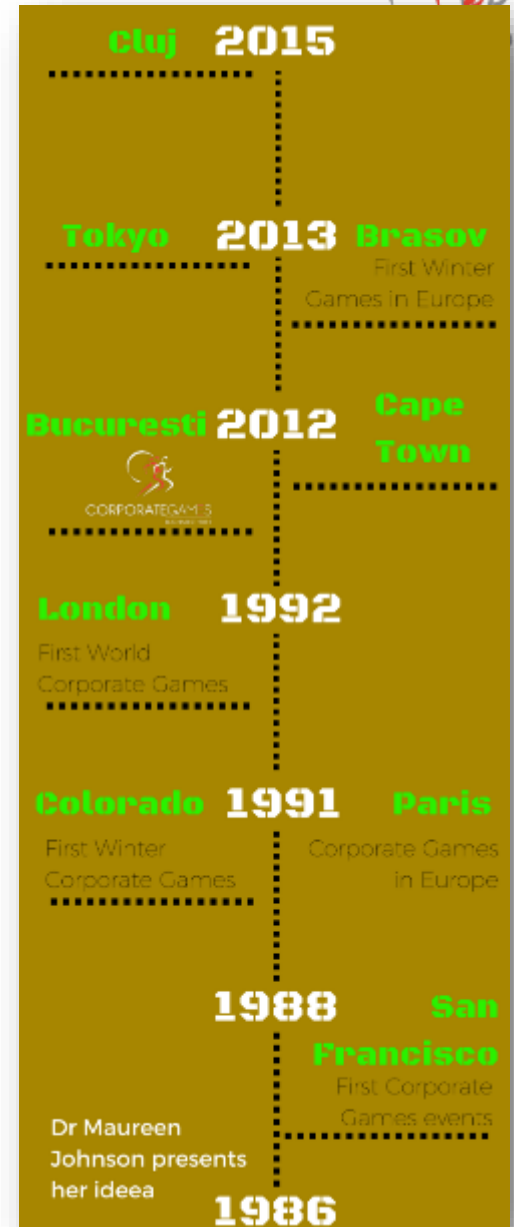

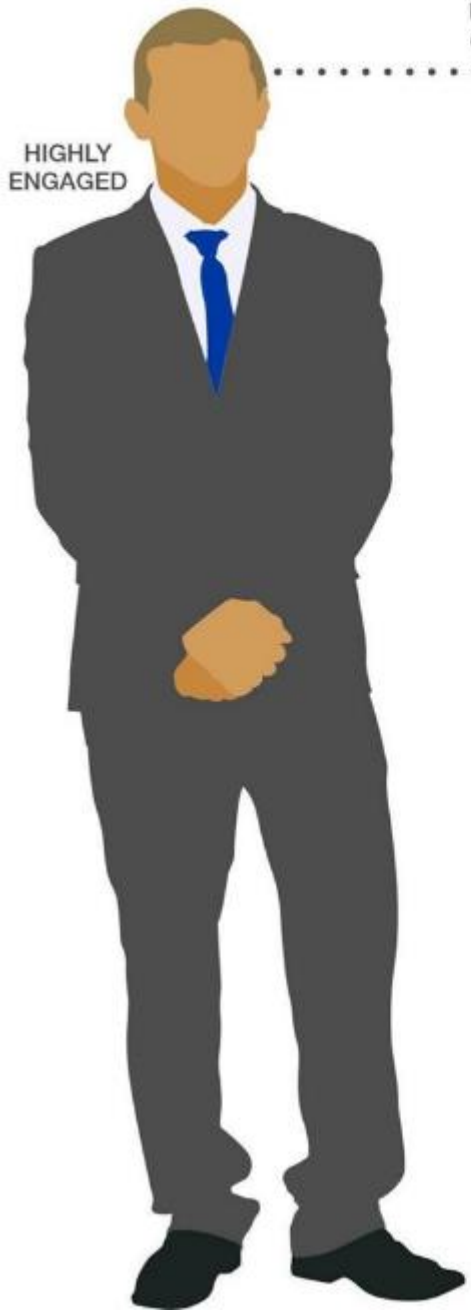

Proportion of low or no engagement employees experiencing this

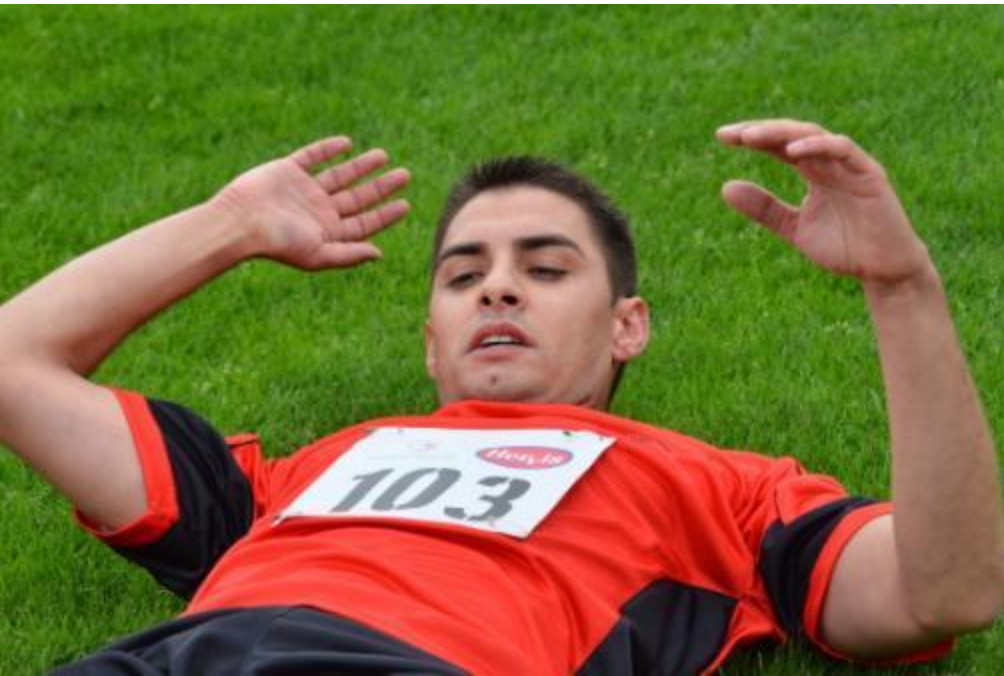

REGULATIONS Basketball 5

Teams, masculine

Pool play followed by elimination tournament. Each match is a minimum of two 15 minute halves with a 1 minute changeover. Time outs: one 30 second

time out per half per team. No stopping of clock for time outs in 1st first half but in 2nd half the clock will stop. The clock will stop in last minute of each half only for free throws. When an elimination is drawn at full time there will be overtime of 2 minutes stopping clock.

REGULATIONS Basketball 3

Teams are scheduled a minim of 3 matches of at least 10 minutes each. Competition is pool play followed by elimination tournament Rolling substitution. Match balls supplied.

FORMAT

Two teams each having 6 players on the court at a time. Play begins with the server throwing the ball over the net to the opponents. The ball remains in play being thrown back and forth across the net until there is a miss. Three players may play the ball before throwing it over the net. If the receiving team misses, the serving team scores a point and the next play begins with the same server. If the serving team misses, it loses the serve. Each match will have 2 halves of 10 minute with one minute break. In case of draw at the end of the match there will be 5 more gameplays allowed for 5 points.

All boats are competing on short distance (200m) and long distance (200m)

Short races may consist of qualification and finals and long race are only one event and results are final.

Medals ranking is determined by the combined results in 200m and 400m races in each category (Masters & Beginners)

Mixed Crews MUST have a minimum of TWO (2) female paddlers in the boat at any time.

Masters are team that have won at least one medal in Dragon Boat at Corporate Games events. All the rest are Rookies.

RULES

FIFA playing rules modified for Corporate Games apply.

REGULATION

No offside. All free kicks are direct. Once goalkeepers have control of the ball in the hands, they may not kick it. It must be thrown out underarm. All offences by the defending team within the penalty area shall result in a penalty kick. No direct back passes after receiving the ball from the goalkeeper. Rolling substitution. No ball height restrictions.

FORMAT

Pool play and elimination tournament scoring system. Each match is a minimum of two 15 minute halves with 2 minutes changeover. When an elimination match is drawn at full-time, two 3 minute halves of extra time are played. If, after extra time there is still no result, each team takes 5 penalties, followed by sudden death.

UNIFORM & EQUIPMENT

Teams must wear appropriate numbered matching shirts. Each player is advised to wear shin pads and must wear shoes without spikes. Match balls are supplied. Practice balls are not. No spikes.

Clothing should include a shirt with skirt or shorts, which should not be predominantly white. Non marking shoes only are allowed. Players must provide their own bats. For Open Singles ITTF regulations require that one surface of the bat is bright red and the other black. The cover rubber needs to be authorized by the ITTF. Match balls are supplied, training balls not.

Elimination and finals matches are full set. At 6-6 a standard tie-break is played.

FORMAT

Pool play followed by elimination tournament.

Each match played rally point is a minimum of two 10 minute halves with a 1 minute changeover. Two time outs are allowed each match. Time outs last a maximum of 1 minute (30 seconds each). No time outs or substitutions are allowed during the last 5 minutes. Rolling substitution, entrance from the net.

When an elimination match is drawn at full time, an extra 5 points, played rally point, decides the winner. First service is given to the team winning the final rally of normal time.

UNIFORM & EQUIPMENT

Teams must wear numbered matching shirts or vests. Match balls are supplied. Practice balls are not.

Pool Playing Scoring System



Pool Play Scoring System

Win = 4 points

Draw = 2 points

Loss = 1 points

Forfeit = 0 points

Pool Start Times

Each player/team is assigned to a specific pool which is given a 'Pool Start Time'. Each pool is played out to completion on the assigned court, field, table or pitch. It is essential that you are present at the assigned Pool Start Time and remain there until all matches of the pool are completed.



Forfeits or No Shows

In the case of a forfeit, the opponent receives 4 points plus a predetermined score as follows:

Basketball	40-0
Football	2-0
Football (6s)	4-0
Volley	20-0
Badminton	21-0
Table Tennis	11-0
Tennis	10-0

If a forfeit takes place during the elimination tournament, or otherwise affects Games Points, all lower placed entrants within the Top 8 shall be moved one position higher and 8th or last place left vacant.
